Our workshops are completely interactive, so be ready to be engaged and inspired!

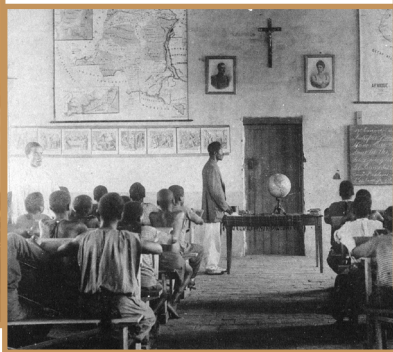
